**Agreement between the City of Vaughan , Recreation and Culture,
Aquatic Services section and Vaughan Aquatic Club
(Amendment # 2)**

SWIM TEAM PRACTISE (*Rental time*)

X procedures during swim club practise as per Ontario Health Act and the City of Vaughan regulations

1. When 25 or less swimmers are present on deck or in the water:

a. One swim coach is to be present on deck and in possession of a current swim coaches certificate and current N.L.S., C.P.R. and A.E.C. or Standard First aid awards.

And

b. One **designated** lifeguard, minimum age 16 years, with current N.L.S., C.P.R. and A.E.C. awards is to be present in the water or on the deck.

2. When 25 to 50 swimmers are present on the deck or in the water:

a. A second swim coach with current swim coaches and A.E.C. or standard First Aid awards to be present on the deck.

And

b. One lifeguard (see 1b)

All coaches and lifeguards should be trained in the City of Vaughan emergency procedures and be able to perform proper spinal treatment. Copies of current qualifications must be on file in the pool office. It is the responsibility of the coaches to provide the Aquatic supervisor and the aquatic Coordinators with new and updated qualifications. Qualifications need to be kept current.

When the above cannot be met at anytime, the coach agrees to cancel the swim practise.

- X Dates/times for swim practise will be provided to the Aquatic Supervisor and the permitting section annually.
- X The Vaughan Aquatic Club is not to compete with the City of Vaughan aquatic programs (e.g. Learn to Swim, Aquafit etc.)
- X The Vaughan aquatic Club agrees that it will, at all times, maintain adequate liability insurance.
- X The use of the flume slide at Dufferin Clark and Maple pools require at all times two lifeguards, one stationed on the top and one on the bottom as per Amusement Devices Act.
- X The City of Vaughan may cease operation due to financial or budgetary restraints. The Dufferin Clark, Woodbridge and Maple pools are closed annually for a two to three week period for maintenance in September and the West Vaughan and Garnet A.W. pools mid June. The City of Vaughan will provide alternative arrangements during these periods.
